

PROCEDURE AND STAGES OF DEALING **OF CRS INQUIRY REPORTS**

Stage-1: Statutory Inquiries into Railway accidents

As per existing rules (Details given in Item No 1.2 on website) Commissioner of Railway Safety of Circle corresponding to the concerned Zonal Railway, is supposed to conduct Inquiries whenever situation so warrants and CRS find it a fit case for inquiry . Public Notification is made and inquiry is conducted , nearest to the accident site . Preliminary Report is submitted by the Commissioner of Railway Safety (CRS) to Chief Commissioner of Railway Safety , Lucknow. Copy of This Preliminary report is marked to

1. Secretary(Safety)/Railway Board ,Ministry Of Railway , New Delhi
2. General Manager of Concerned Railway.
3. Principal Information Officer,Press Information Bureau, New Delhi

Stage-2: Processing of PRELIMINARY Report of CRS at MoR

As soon as the Preliminary Report of CRS is received in Office of **ADVISOR(SAFETY)** [Secretary(Safety)]it is marked to Director/Safety-IV. Director/Safety-IV , forwards the report to the concerned AMs for examination and action taken comments. After review of Full Board the file is returned to Advisor/Safety

Stage-3: FINAL Report at CRS

After Preliminary Report CRS sends the FINAL REPORT to **ADVISOR(SAFETY)** .it is marked to Director/Safety-IV. Director/Safety-IV , forwards the report to the concerned AMs for examination and action taken comments. Subsequently the report is put up to to Adv./Safety.

Stage-4: FINAL NOTE of CCRS

It comprised of CRS' Recommendations of Final Report, GM's action taken comments, and CCRS' comments. Now Director(Safety) IV circulates the CCRS Final note for compliance of the RECCOMENDATION. Meetings are hold with concerned directorates for expediting the same.

Stage-5: Issue of OM(Office Memorandum) by Ministry of Railways

After collection of ACTION TAKEN NOTE of all concerned directorates, OM is issued.

Stage-6: Passing by Parliament and Publishing the CRS Report by Ministry of Civil Aviation

CCRS present the Final Report to Parliament. Abstracts of Railway Accident Inquiry Report is published by the Commission of Railway Safety.
